Fresh from the Farm, Healthy Fundraising for Ontario Schools, provides schools the opportunity to raise funds by selling fresh, Ontario-grown fruit and vegetables to the community, while promoting healthy eating and supporting Ontario farmers. Fresh from the Farm is a single fundraising event, with a scheduled delivery date to be confirmed in November. Attached to this letter you will find a Fresh from the Farm Student Order form. Families can choose either Bundle A or Bundle B, or BOTH. All fruit and vegetable products are supplied by growers throughout various regions of Ontario. These are all pantry/fridge staples and we hope many of our families will be pleased to support the school with items that would be normal grocery purchases, while supporting Ontario farmers.

Two 'Bundles' of Ontario-grown fruit and vegetables are offered for sale:

- priced at \$13, bundle A includes – 5 lb white potatoes, 3 lb carrots, 3 lb yellow onions, and 3 lb sweet potatoes
- priced at \$15, bundle B includes - 8 lbs of Empire apples.

Fruit and vegetable products are supplied by growers throughout various regions of Ontario. Please take every opportunity to sell this product to all of your acquaintances – co-workers, friends, family etc... Please remember that students are not permitted to sell door to door.

Please make all cheques payable to Summit Alternative School Council. Orders must be returned to the school office no later than Wednesday, October 4th, 2017. Please ensure each order form has your name on it when you return it at the end of the campaign. Your forms will be returned to you with your order and parents/students will be notified as to when they can pick up their orders.
