

FISHER / SUMMIT LUNCH PROGRAMS

The Fisher Park and Summit Parent Councils offer weekly lunch programs throughout the school year. Students pre-order from a set menu for selected dates. Food is delivered to the school and handed out by volunteer students and parents. The lunch programs are important fundraisers for the Councils. Money raised is used to enrich programming and opportunities for students.

This year, **pizza** is available on Wednesdays and **pitas** on Tuesdays. **Ordering is done online at:**

The websites are linked, so you can access one from the other and registration is valid for both. The access code to register is **FPHL**. If you don't have Internet access, order forms are available at the school office upon request.

Orders for the first FALL lunch session are due as follows:

Pizza - **Sept. 16** for the first lunch on Wednesday, **Sept. 19**
Pitas - **Sept. 11** for the first lunch on Tuesday, **Sept. 18**

There will be another session later, for the second half of the year. Note that you can place orders throughout the sessions. See hotlunches site for details.
