Free On-line Homework Help in Mathematics offered by the Ottawa-Carleton District School Board



The Ottawa-Carleton District School Board, the Independent Learning Centre and the Ontario Ministry of Education continue to partner together to bring Homework Help in Mathematics to students. This free website focuses on live math help from certified teachers for students taking Grades 7, 8, 9 and 10 Math during this school year. Key aspects of the website include:

- ✓ *Free online one-on-one tutoring by certified Ontario math teachers*
- ✓ *Interactive tutorials*
- ✓ *Pre-recorded tutoring sessions available by topic*
- ✓ *A full mathematics glossary and calculator*

The free tutoring component of the website is available Sunday through Thursday from 5:30PM to 9:30PM. All other aspects of the website are available at any time.

Please be advised that your child's login information will be used by the Ontario Ministry of Education for tracking purposes to help monitor the use of this service by students across the province. The use of this information is strictly confidential. Your child's identity will not be revealed in any reporting of this information.



Your son/daughter can be register on the Homework Help website. Registration may take place at school. If you do not want your child registered, please contact your child's principal.

Registration Instructions

Step #1 - Go to the website: www.homeworkhelp.ilc.org
Click on **FREE REGISTRATION** or **Register Now**.

Step #2 – Ontario Education Number (OEN), and date of birth.
❖ *Please obtain the OEN number from your report card, timetable, or teacher*

Step #3 – Create a username and password; verify the password
❖ *It is strongly encouraged that students choose a Username that allows them to remain anonymous.*

Step #4 - Your e-mail address (optional but recommended)
❖ *Please enter a valid e-mail address...*
❖ *...it is optional to include an e-mail address, but students are encouraged to do so in the event that they forget their username and password. They will also receive technical support, valuable reminders about upcoming dates and events (EQAO, exams), updates, and tips.*

- ❖ *After this registration process, you will be able to login using your Username and Password at the top right of the welcome screen.*
- ❖ *Students may register as a Guest at any time, but will be unable to ask questions to the tutors in the Chat Rooms.*
